IMPORTANT INFORMATION

DRESS CODE

A smart dress code applies on match days.

The following items of clothing are not permitted:
Sportswear, tracksuits, clothing displaying any offensive branding,
and replica football shirts (including Club and Away Club colours).

Smart jeans are permitted.

All footwear must be clean and smart in appearance.

It is your responsibility to inform your guests of the dress code.

The dress code does not apply to children 14 and under.

AWAY FANS*

The Club must be made aware of any guests who are away fans upon arrival to Molineux.

Whilst we welcome away fans, we kindly ask them to not make themselves be known to avoid ejection from the stadium.

BAG CHECKS

All bags must be no larger than A4 size. Guests that do decide to bring their own bags will be doing so at their own risk. We are unable to hold or store guests' bags and other personal belongings.

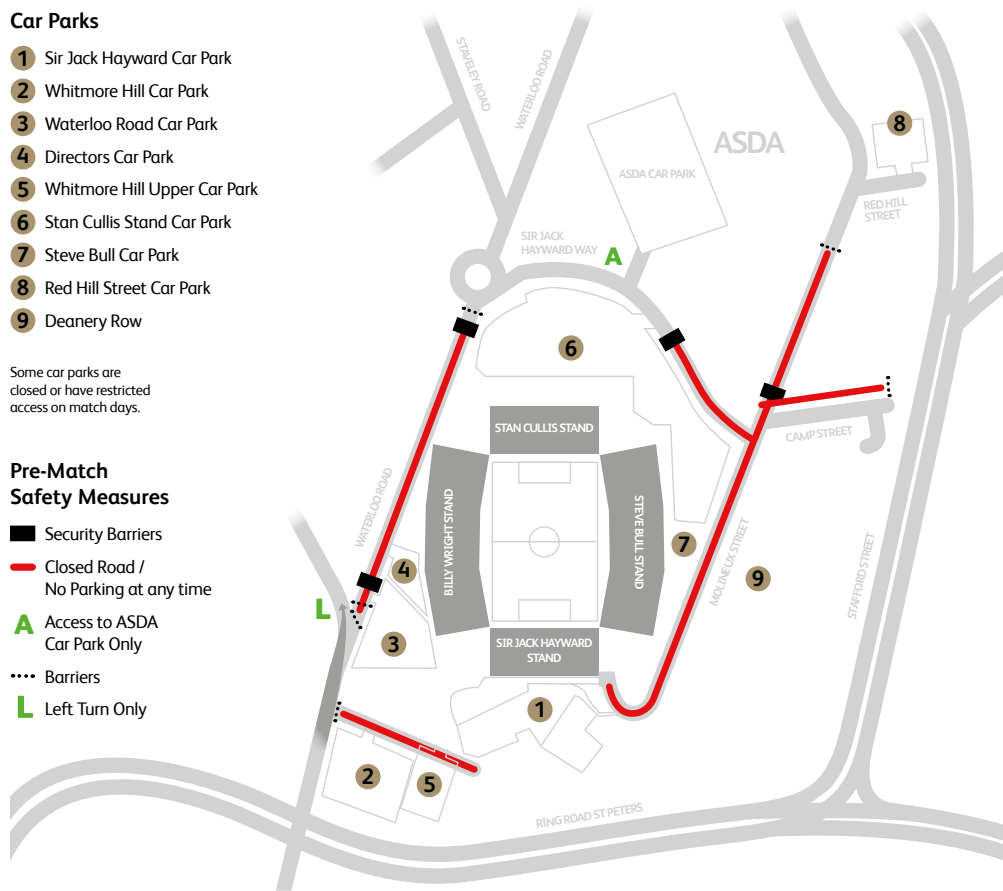

Waterloo Road

Will be closed from the roundabout leading to Asda up to the traffic lights at Newhampton Road from 90 minutes before kick-off.

Molineux Street

Will be closed at the junction with Camp Street and Sir Jack Hayward Way, Sir Jack Hayward Way opposite the Stan Cullis Car Park kiosk and to the top of Whitmore Hill from one hour before kick-off.

These roads will be re-opened at the discretion of the Matchday Safety Officer, expected to be 15 - 30 minutes after the end of the game.
